MILLERSPORT PHARMACY BROKEN INTO, SUSPECT CAPTURED, ARRESTED

[Lancaster, Ohio May 19, 2010] Fairfield County Sheriff Dave Phalen says that a deputy patrolling the Village of Millersport was alerted to the Millersport Pharmacy by the store's audible alarm. Phalen says that Deputy Michael Ash was already investigating the B&E when the call from the alarm company finally came into the communications center at 12:30 a.m.

Phalen says that as additional personnel arrived in the area, a suspect was located nearby along with bags of prescriptions from the pharmacy. "He took prescriptions that had already been filled and ready to be picked up by customers," Phalen added.

Phalen says that **ROBERT A. NEAGOS**, 25, of Newark has been arrested and charged with one (1) count of Breaking and Entering. He is being held in the Fairfield County Jail. Breaking and Entering is a felony of the fifth degree, punishable by up to one (1) year in prison. The investigation is continuing, and additional charges are possible.
